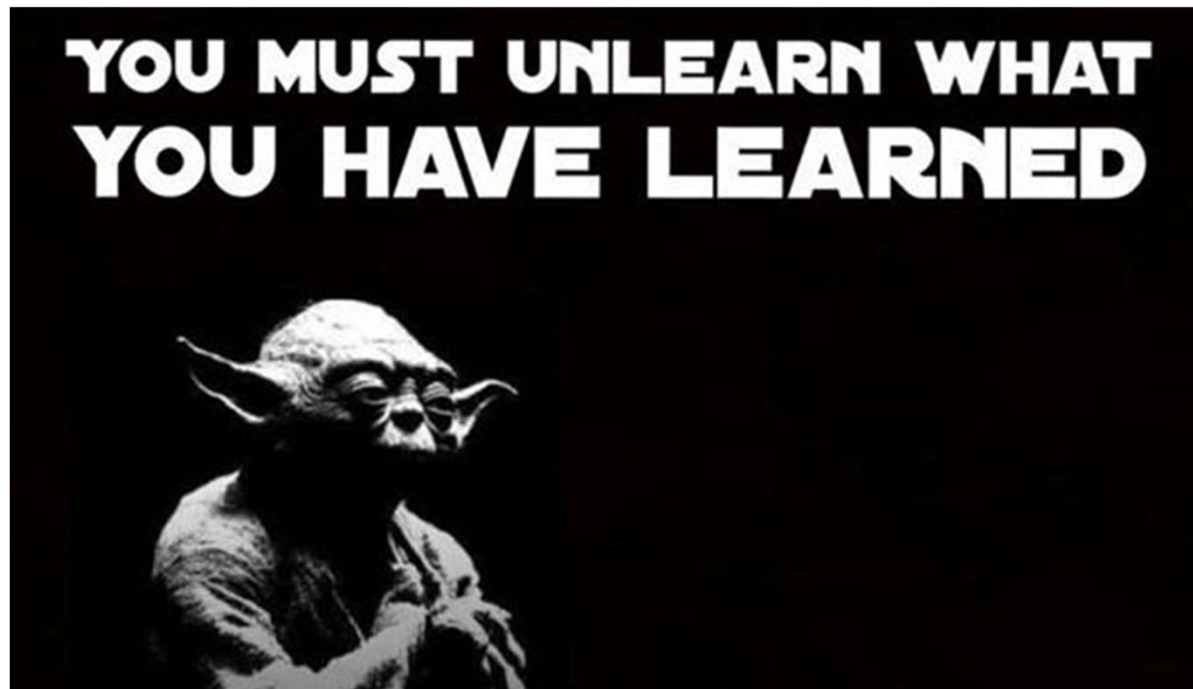


What is a Dichotomy?

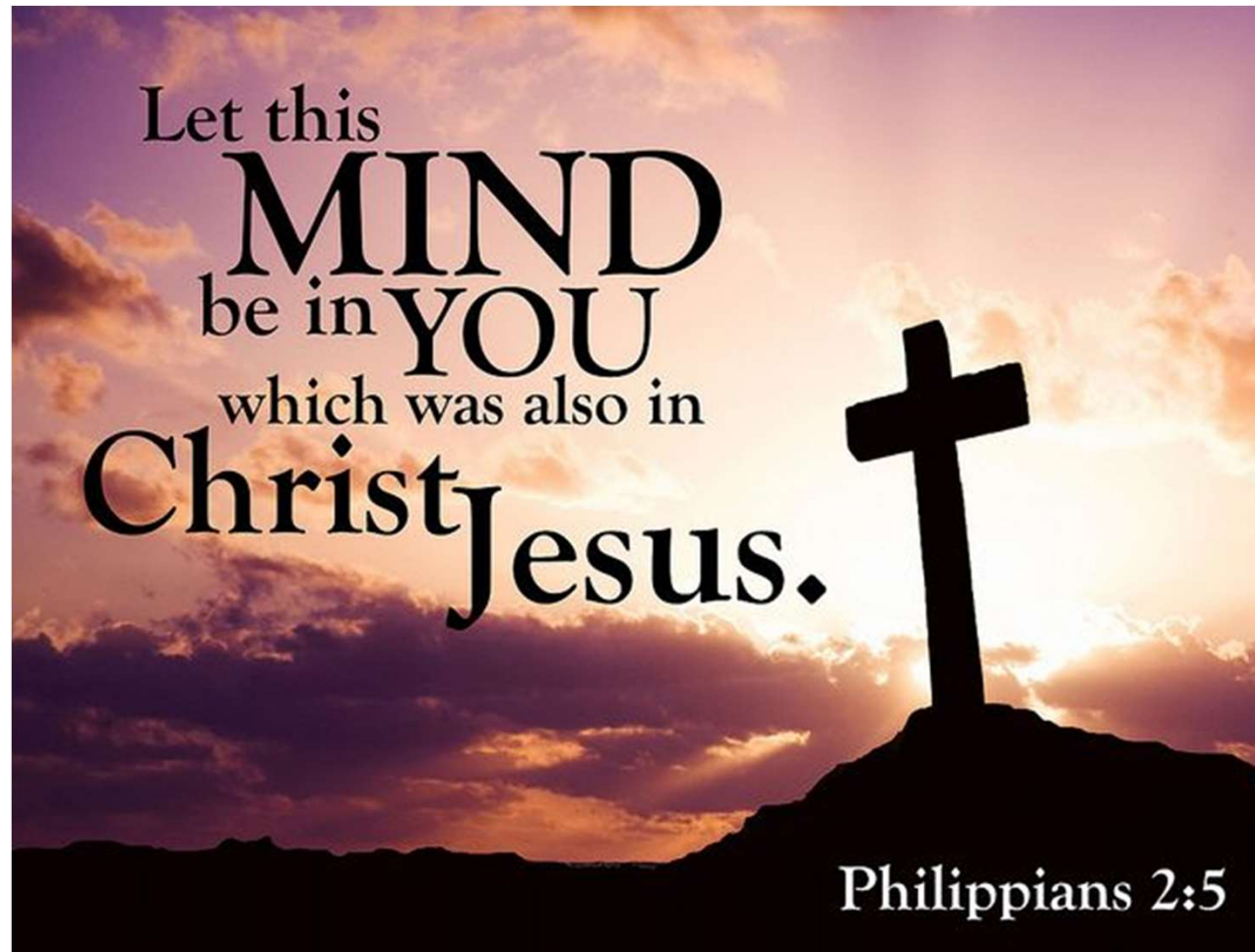
