#### Translation Matters

- ♦ Luke 1:28 in Latin Vulgate
  - · have gratia plena
  - = Hail full of grace
- ♦ Luke 1:28 in Greek NT
  - χαῖρε, κεχαριτωμένη
  - = greetings highly favored one

#### Elsewhere in the NT



- ♦ Stephen, <u>full of grace</u> and power, did great wonders and signs among the people. (Acts 6:8 NRSV)

### "Full of Grace"

- **\* the Word became flesh and lived among us...full of grace and truth....From his fullness** we have all received, grace upon grace. (John 1:14, 16 NRSV)
- each of us was given grace according to the measure of Christ's gift. (Ephesians 4:7 NRSV)

all who are indwelled by the Holy Spirit are, as it were, carrying the Spirit like in pregnancy! Just as Mary was pregnant with the Son of God, so Jesus-disciples are pregnant with the Holy Spirit—a divine personage resides in both. So, just as Mary birthed Jesus, Spiritfilled Christians birth (or produce) the fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:21-22) specifically and the life of Christ generally (Col 3:1–17).

## Grace Expressed
