#### Divided Kingdom

### Northern Kingdom = Israel (930–722 BC)

- 19 monarchs all evil
- Exiled by the Assyrian Empire

### Southern Kingdom = Judah (930–586 BC)

- 20 monarchs about half righteous
- Exiled by the Babylonian Empire







# The Consequence of Solomon's Idolatry


















### Roman Empire Occupancy in NT

Former Southern Kingdom / Judah = Judea & Idumea








#### The Fall of Empire


- After WWI, the Ottoman Empire was parceled up

### Israel becomes a state in 1948




### Jerusalem

### Exhortation
