



Gospel	Audience	Purpose
Matthew	Jews	Jesus = Messiah/Christ
Mark	Romans	Jesus = GoodNews
Luke	Gentiles	Jesus = Savior
John	Church	Jesus = Divine-Human

Continuum of Citation



But if you are not listened to, take one or two others along with you, so that every word may be confirmed by the evidence of two or three witnesses. ...For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them. (Matthew 18:16, 20 NRSV; cf. Deuteronomy 17:6; 19:15)

Matthew, Mark, & Luke = 3 witnesses
Synoptic Gospels + Gospel of John = 2 witnesses
