



 ⁴⁴ Then Jesus cried out and said,
"He who believes in Me, believes not in Me but in Him who sent Me. ⁴⁵ And he who sees Me sees Him who sent Me.

⁴⁶ I have come as a Light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness. ⁴⁷ And if anyone hears My Words and does not believe, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world.

⁴⁸ He who rejects Me, and does not receive My Words, has that which judges him—The Word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day. ⁴⁹ For I have not spoken on My own *authority;* but The Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. ⁵⁰ And I know that His Command is Everlasting Life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak."



Defining Apologetics:


APOLOGETICS - [APOL-O-GET-ICS]

Derived from the Greek word: apologia meaning "speaking in defense"



Defining Apologetics:

- Refers to systematic argumentative discourse
- An alternative view of a topic is offered in an organized fashion
- Shouldn't be argumentative in the sense of being quarrelsome
- The intellectual defense of the truth of the Christian religion/{Spiritual Beliefs}
- The rational response against the objections people bring up about Christianity
- The Greek word *apologia*, is simply an answer given in reply.





Our Scriptural Premise:


FROM THE GREEK WORD: "APOLOGIA"

From First Peter 3:15, "always being prepared to <u>make a defense</u> (Gr. *apologia*) to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you"

John 12: 44 – 50

The phrase "I Am..." appears ~ 65 ~ times in The Gospel of John (CEV).

<u>Unapologetic Apologetics:</u>


- Not a systematic argumentative discourse

- Not being argumentative or being quarrelsome
- Not an intellectual defense of the truth of the Christian religion/{Spiritual Beliefs}
- Not the rational response against the objections people bring up about Christianity
- The Greek word *apologia*, is simply an answer given in reply to Who we ARE
