

#### A.W.A.R.E.


## The **A**bility to **W**ait **A**nd **R**eceive **E**vidence (**R**ecognize **E**volve)

- The ability to wait on God so that we can see and understand HOW we are to organize and prioritize for The Kingdom and in life;
  - To receive/recognize and discern God's Voice from all others and all else;
  - To learn, know and perceive evidence that comes from God.
    - To evolve = advance, expand, enlarge.

### Awareness of The Holy Spirit and Discernment Re – organizes our minds and Prioritizes our thoughts for Kingdom Thinking/Awareness

## Organize and Prioritize for The Kingdom = It's a Head/Mind Job/Action

¹Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who by faith have testified to the truth of God's absolute faithfulness], stripping off every unnecessary weight and the sin which so easily and cleverly entangles us, let us run with endurance and active persistence the race that is set before us, ² [looking away from all that will distract us and] focusing our eyes on Jesus, who is the Author and Perfecter of faith [the first incentive for our belief and the One who brings our faith to maturity],³ Just consider and meditate on Him who endured from sinners such bitter hostility against Himself [consider it all in comparison with your trials], so that you will not grow weary and lose heart ..." Amp Version
