



Organizing /Organize

- To arrange into a structured whole; order;
- To coordinate the activities of (a person or group of people) efficiently;
- To put persons or things into their proper places in relation to each other.

Organize/order suggests to put in order or straightening out so as to eliminate confusion.

Prioritizing/Prioritize

- To designate or treat (something) as more important than other things;
- To determine the order for dealing with (a series of items or tasks) according to their relative importance;
- To assign rank, rating, place or order

How do we Organize and Prioritize for The Kingdom?

*Awareness of The Holy Spirit
and
The need for discernment*

A.W.A.R.E.

The **A**bility to **W**ait **A**nd **R**eceive **E**vidence
(**R**ecognize **E**volve)

- The ability to wait on God so that we can see and understand HOW we are to organize and prioritize for The Kingdom and in life;
- To receive/recognize and discern God's Voice from all others and all else;
- To learn, know and perceive evidence that comes **from God**.
 - To evolve = advance, expand, enlarge.

Awareness of The Holy Spirit and Discernment

Re - organizes our minds and Prioritizes our thoughts for Kingdom Thinking/Awareness

“He endured the cross, scorning its shame!”

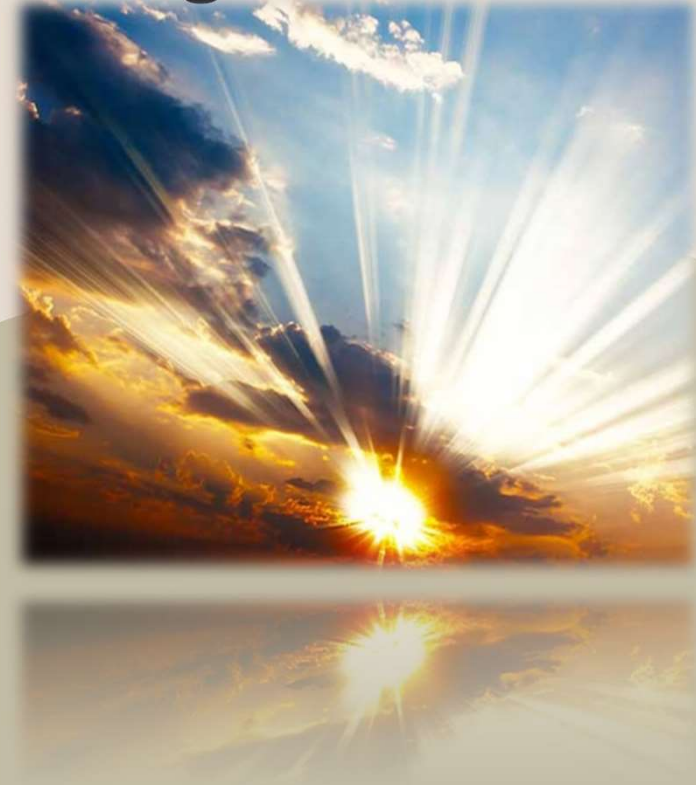
How does a “King’s Kid” think, act, believe?

**Organize and Prioritize for The Kingdom =
It's a Head/Mind Job/Action**

¹ Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [who by faith have testified to the truth of God's absolute faithfulness], stripping off every unnecessary weight and the sin which so easily *and* cleverly entangles us, let us run with endurance *and* active persistence the race that is set before us, ² [looking away from all that will distract us and] focusing our eyes on Jesus, who is the Author and Perfecter of faith [the first incentive for our belief and the One who brings our faith to maturity], ³ Just consider *and* meditate on Him who endured from sinners such bitter hostility against Himself [consider it all in comparison with your trials], so that you will not grow weary and lose heart ...” *Amp Version*
