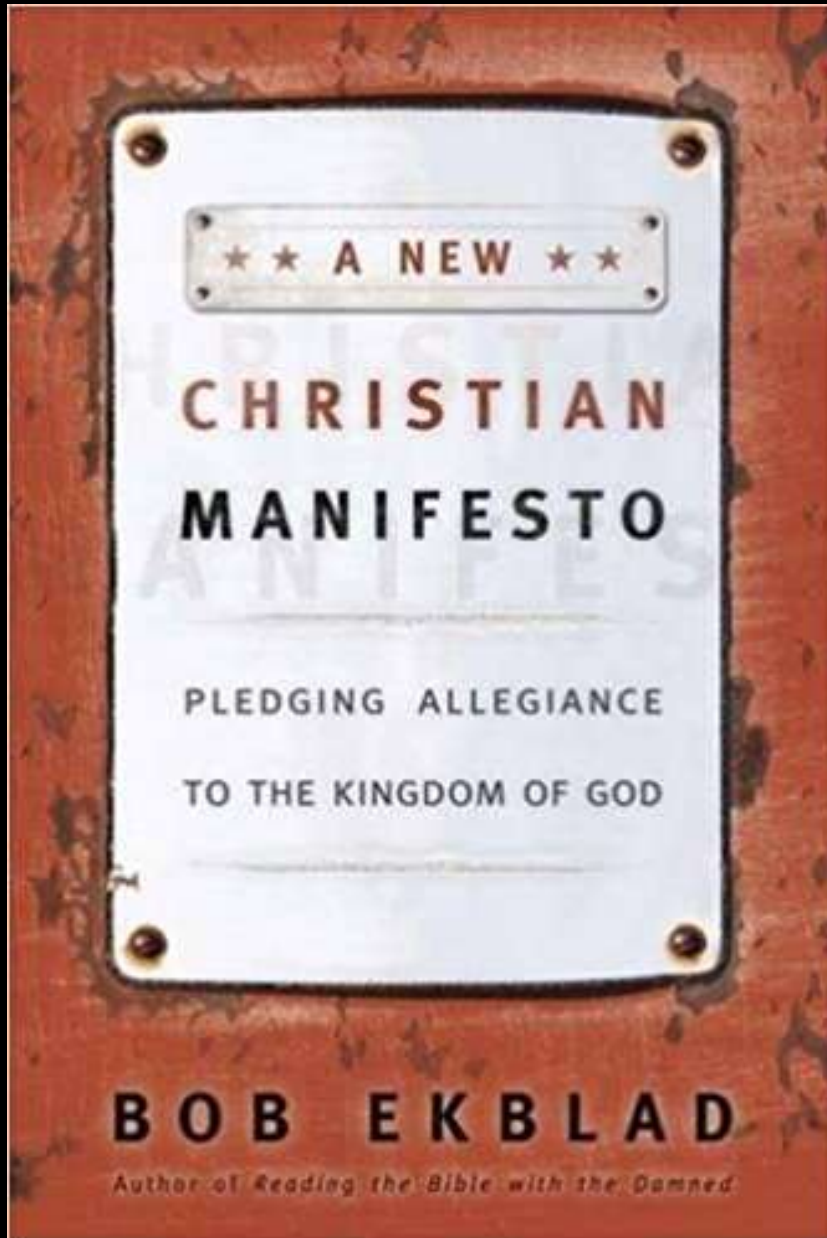

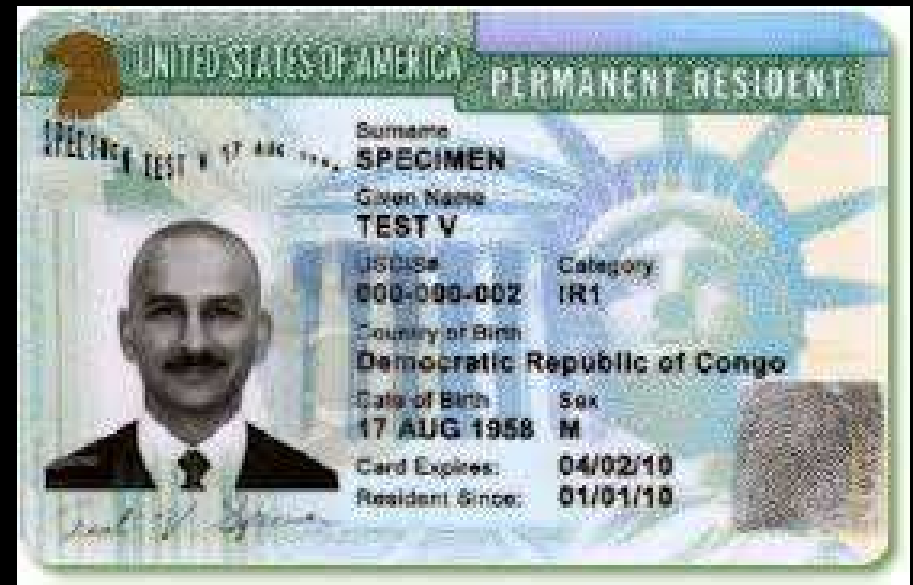

Jesus
