

DIVINE DISTRESS:


But when in their distress they turned to The LORD, The God of Israel, and sought Him, He was found by them. ² Chronicles 15:4

In my distress I called upon The LORD, and cried unto My God. Ps. 18:6

DEFINE DISTRESS:

Extreme anxiety, sorrow, or pain: I called upon The LORD in distress: The LORD answered me, [and set me] in a large place. Ps. 118: 5

To cause (someone) anxiety, ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of sorrow, or pain: Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress...



Common Distress Signals:

<u>Health</u> Fevers, Unconsciousness, Pain

<u>Weather</u> Winds/Rain, Alarms

<u>Traffic</u> Red/Blue Flashing Lights Sirens Hazard Lights
