DEFINE DICHOTOMY:

A division or contrast between two things that are or are represented as being opposed or entirely different.

Late 16th century: modern Latin from Greek dikhotomia, from dikho - 'in two, apart' + tomia (see - tomy).

The Dichotomy of Culture:
TDC
Tradition, Dogma & Condemnation

C = Condemnation/Criticism

D = Damnation/Demonization

F = Failure/Foolish

H = Hate/Hell

S = Satan/Sin

Seeing 2 Separate Parts Contradiction/Competition



The Dichotomy of The Cross: R R & D Redemption/Relationship/Divinity

C = Condemnation/Criticism
Compassion/ Caring
D = Damnation/Divinity
F = Failure/Freedom
H = Hate/Hell/ Healing/Heaven
S = Satan/Sin
Son/Salvation

DIVINE DICHOTOMY:

In the world you will have <u>tribulation</u>; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world. *John 16:33*

"I Am The Resurrection and The Life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live... "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see The Glory of God?" John 11:25; 40

Cursed is the man who hangs on a tree.




What are We Seeing?"

We cannot HAVE SALVATION without THE SON!!


What Are We Seeing?
