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# Balancing Engagement & Detachment Mature Active Nonconformists Balance

- An even distribution of weight enabling someone or something
- · to remain upright and steady: stability, steadiness, footing
- A condition in which different elements are equal or in the correct proportions: fairness, justice, impartiality
- to keep a balance between work and relaxation.
- Spiritual balance refers to a state of harmony with oneself and with others. It is a result of an unimpeded flow of energy that is expressed through the body, mind, emotions, soul, and spirit.
- In Christian Spirituality, balance has more to do with temperance, which means that we allow our deepest principles to hold our passions in check.

- The state of being UNemotionally or personally involved
- Indifference, in order to maximize a person's availability to God and to their neighbors.
