What does it mean to "Say less?"

"Say less" - slang phrase
"I understand" or
"I get it."

It's essentially a way to say that you've gotten the point or the gist of something,

you understand what someone is saying, so they don't need to elaborate. It can also be used to confirm that you are willing to help someone or do a task. Sometimes, it's used to express agreement...
so there's no need for the other

so there's no need for the other person to explain any further.



"Say Less" for Jesus Literally




