

Aloof and Afar:

Aloof ~ One who is not friendly or forthcoming; cool and distant:

Afar ~ (Location) From, to or at a great distance

Something/someone hard to understand or explain; not readily investigated, interpreted, or understood; A mysterious person, obscure

Unfriendly, not forthcoming; cool and distant. Not readily investigated, uninterpreted, misunderstood

We are SPIRITUAL BEINGS having a HUMAN EXPERIENCE!


What IS the evil within Us/Me? Am I willing to look at the Evil One/ The OGRE in me...
