



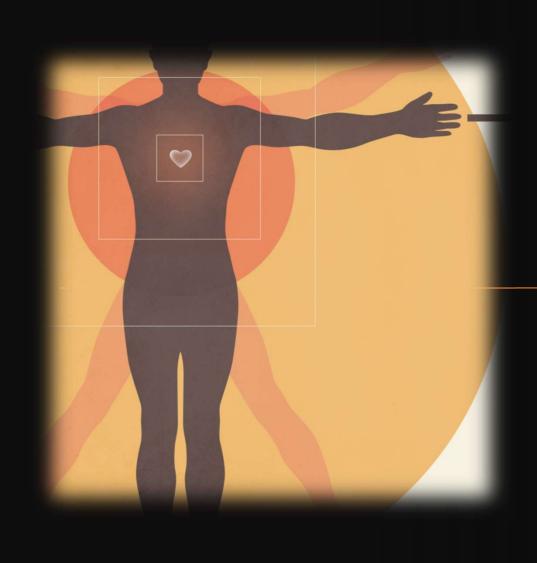

In just the New Testament alone, the words "faithful" and "faithfulness" occur approximately 56 times in the NET Bible, 49 in the NASB and 47 in the NIV. In the Old Testament these two words occur 95 times in the NIV and 86 in the NASB. This repetition speaks loudly for the importance and need of this spiritual quality both to the people of God who depend on God's faithfulness and in the people of God as His people who are to faithfully model God's Character.





Only fear The Lord and serve Him faithfully with all your heart. For consider what great things He has done for you.


Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who Promised is Faithful.

Eliminating

The Spiritual Elimination System:


Elimination is the complete removal or destruction of something, the exclusion of someone or something from consideration or further participation, expulsion of waste matter from the Spirit, Mind and body ...

e-Xcess

A surplus of material or wealth, especially food or drink. Scripture criticizes excessive consumption and extravagance, which are seen as exploiting the less fortunate and leading to a lack of concern for God. The state of surpassing normal limits or needs; superabundance; An <u>undue indulgence of the appetite</u>; transgression of proper moderation in natural

gratifications; unsavedness, wastefulness - debauchery.

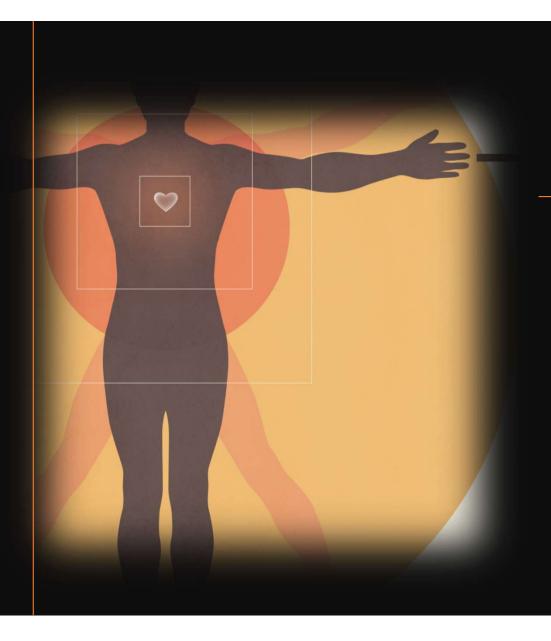
