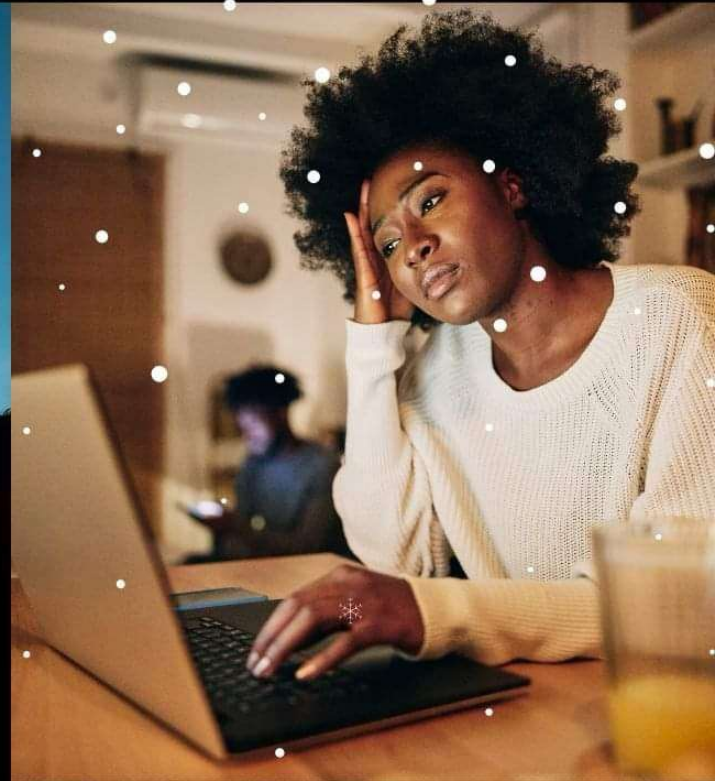

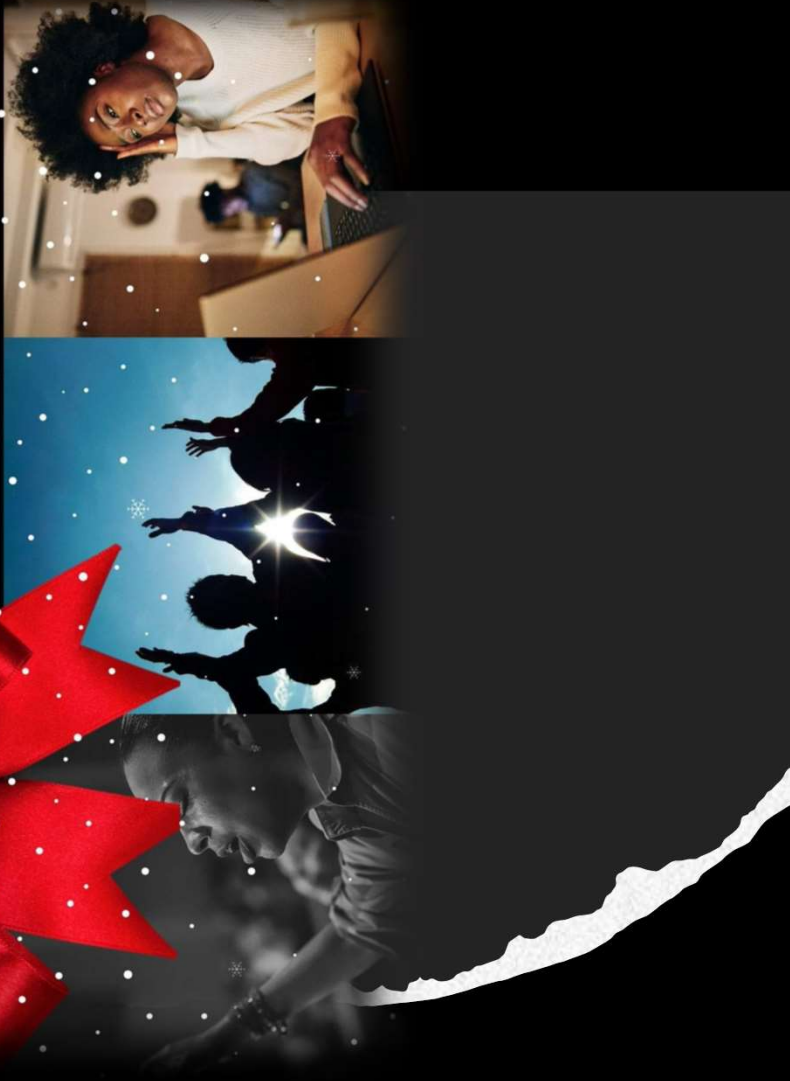

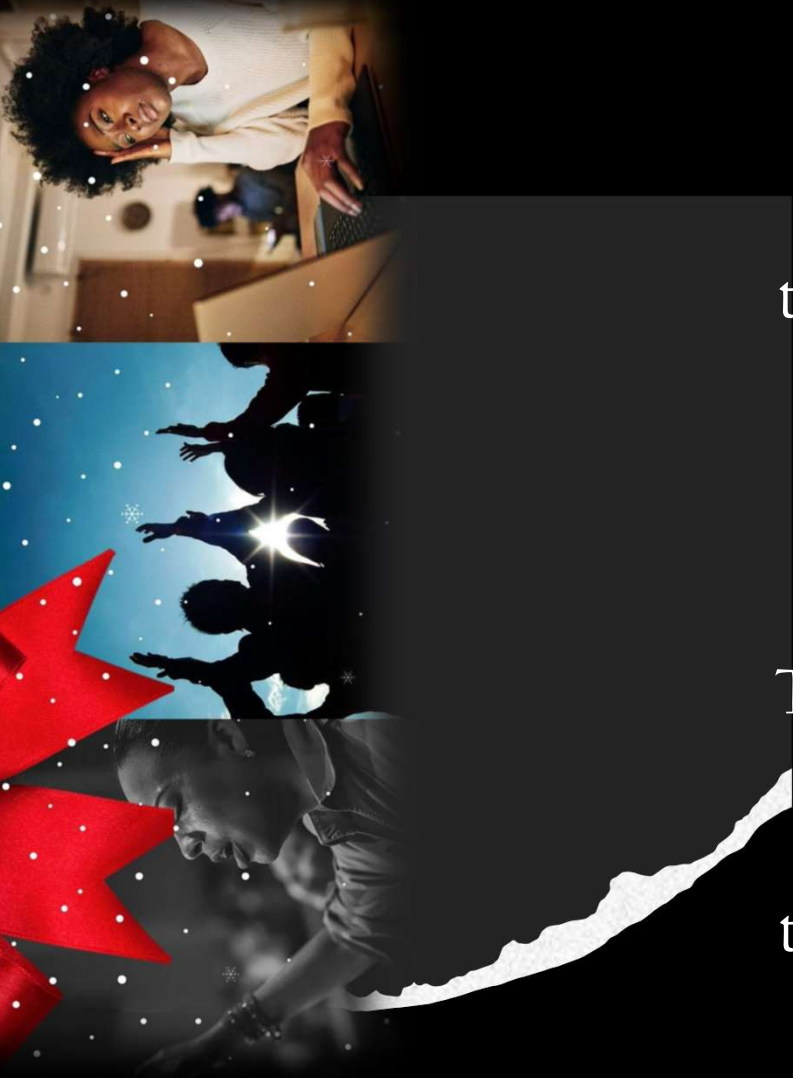
“*Re-Joy-Sing: Unshaken Joy This Christmas,*” is a real talk series inspired by Mary’s song in Luke 1:46-47.

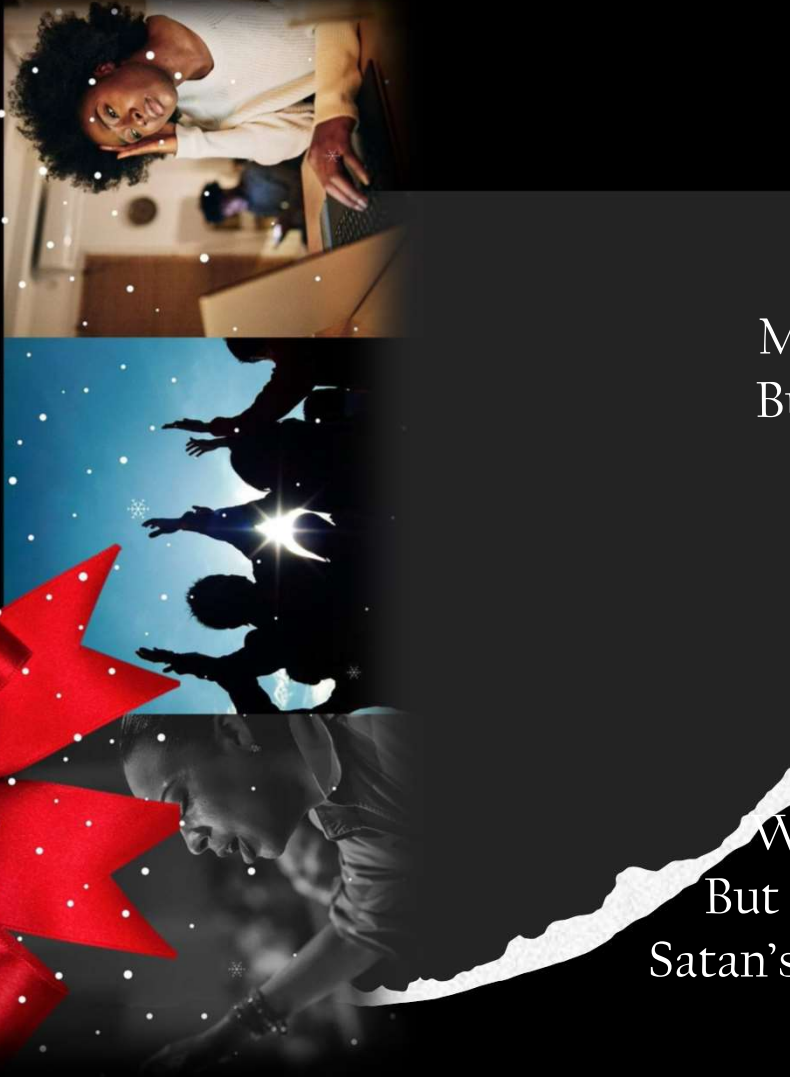

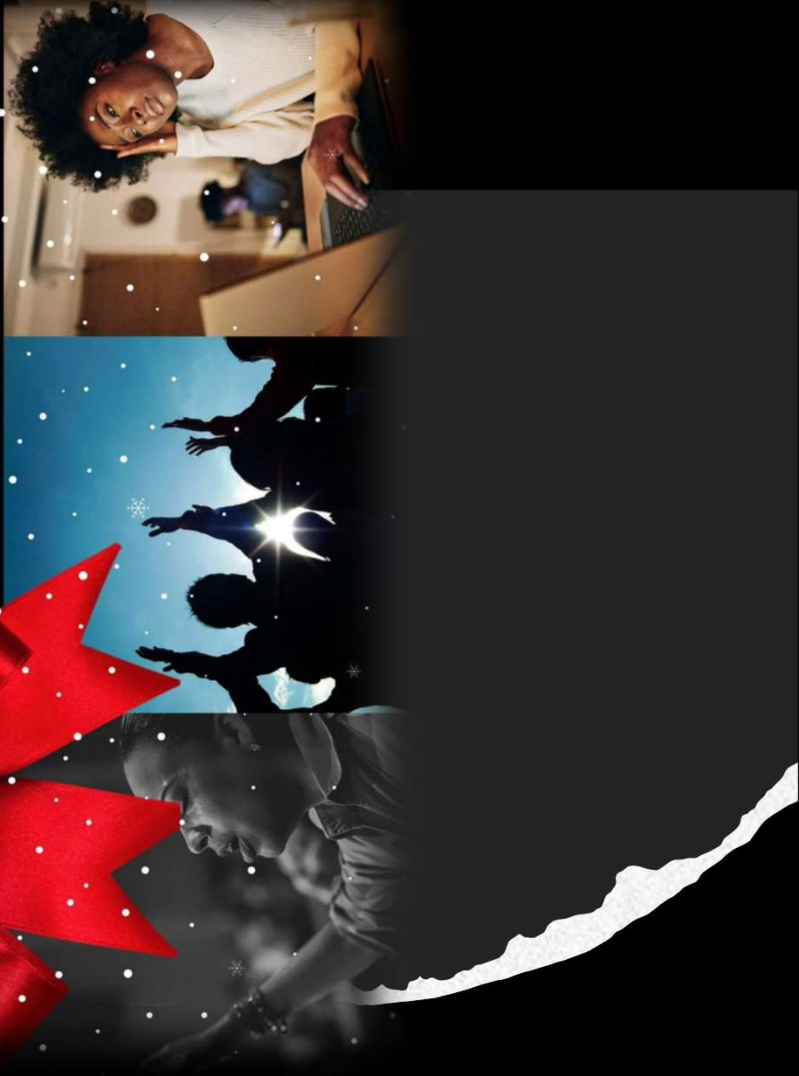
Oh, I want to see Him, look upon His face,

Till my raptured soul shall find rest beyond the river.

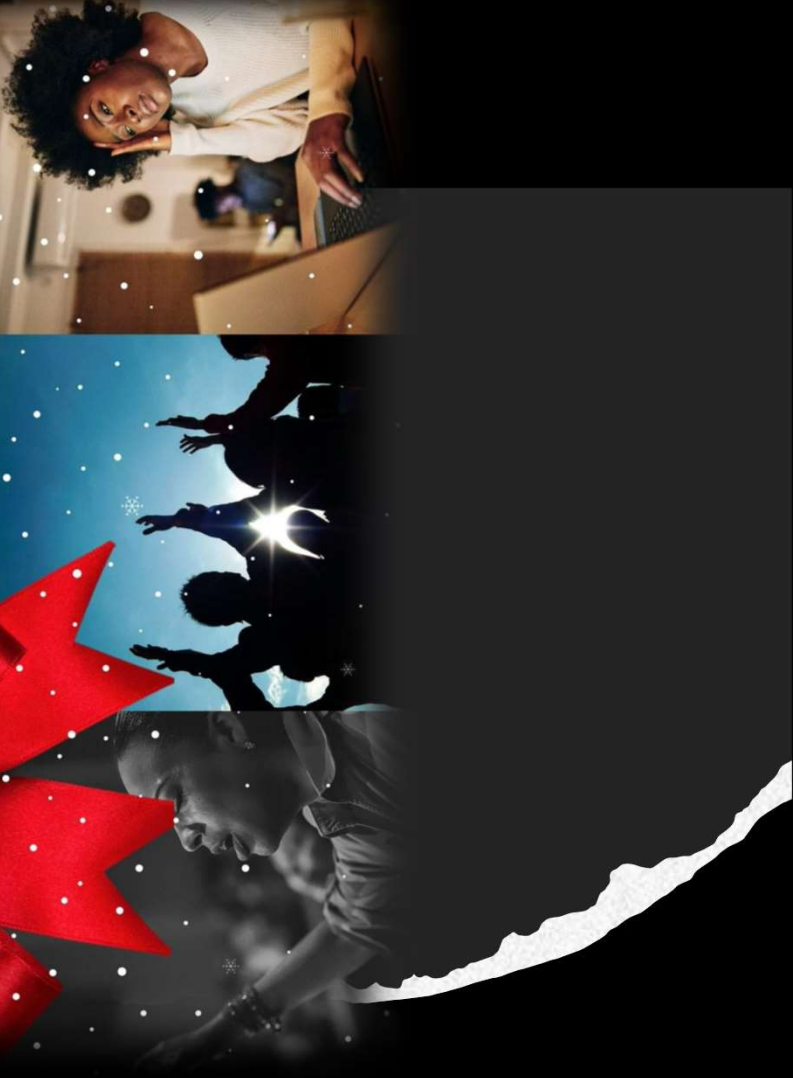

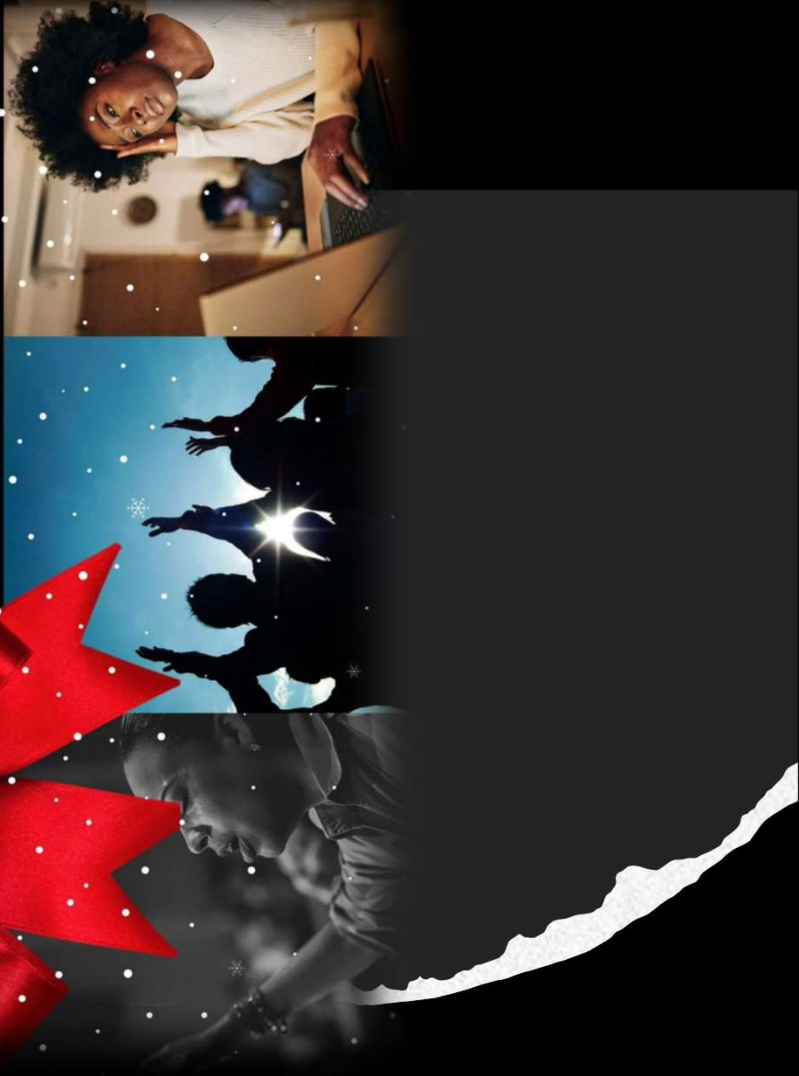
