Matthew 28:16-20

- 16 Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. "διστάζω" (distazō)
- 18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on
- earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all
- nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them
 - to obey everything I have commanded you. (Executive orders)

Grace and Gut Truth Model John 8:1–11 (NIV)

- 1 But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.
- 2 At dawn he appeared again in the temple courts, where **all the people** gathered around him, and he sat down to teach them.
- 3 The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group
 - 4 and said to Jesus, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery.
 - 5 In the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women. Now what do you say?"
- 6 They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing him. But Jesus bent down and started to write on the ground with his finger.
- 7 When they kept on questioning him, he straightened up and said to them, "Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."

John 8:10-11 (NIV) "Jesus straightened up and asked her, Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she said. Then neither do I condemn you,' Jesus declared. Go now and leave your life of sin."

MATTHEW 9:35-38

And Jesus went throughout **all the cities and villages**, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction. When he saw the crowds, he had **compassion** for them, because **they were harassed and helpless**,

like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."

Without laborers and harvesters, the fruit is harassed and spiritually vulnerable GAP so they can get connected
