

- 1. "to separate, distinguish, discern."
- 2. The ability to see the distinctions, make sense of things, and grasp how they fit together.
- 3. The skill to connect cause and effect, to apply truth appropriately in different situations.
- 4. It's insight, discernment, and comprehension at a deeper level than just knowing facts.

Ephesians 1:17–18 (KJV)

CHRISTIANS ARE BEING DRAGGED IN A DAY LIKE TODAY

Acts 16:19 When her owners realized that their hope of making money was gone, they seized Paul and Silas and dragged them into the marketplace to face the authorities. (NIV)

ACTS 16:19-24 (NIV)

- 19 "When her owners realized that their hope of making money was gone, they seized Paul and Silas and dragged them into the marketplace to face the authorities.
 - 22 The crowd joined in the attack against Paul and Silas, and the magistrates ordered them to be stripped and beaten with rods.
- 23 After they had been severely flogged, they were thrown into prison, and the jailer was commanded to guard them carefully.
- 24 When he received these orders, he put them in the inner cell and fastened their feet in the stocks.

"SOMETIMES THE LOUDEST ACCUSATIONS COME FROM THE ONES WHO STAND TO LOSE THE MOST IF YOU'RE RIGHT."

Jesus was accused of blasphemy, challenged by religious leaders, and ultimately crucified. Why?

If He was right, He threatened their religious control and exposed their hypocrisy.

➤ SOMETIMES GOD DOESN'T
PREVENT THE INJUSTICE, BUT HE
WILL SHOW UP IN UNDENIABLE
POWER. PERHAPS EARTHQUAKE
WAS THE METHOD OF CHOICE
OVER EXAMINATION (CROSS)
