What is Your Learning Style?

What is Your Learning Style/Preference?

VARK Model: Developed by Neil Fleming, this model categorizes learners into four primary styles:

- **Visual:** Learners who prefer using images, diagrams, and charts to understand information.
- **Auditory:** Learners who benefit from listening to spoken information, discussions, and lectures.
- **Reading/Writing:** Learners who prefer engaging with text, including reading and writing activities.
- **Kinesthetic:** Learners who learn best through hands-on experiences and physical activities.





Honey and Mumford's Model: Identifies four distinct learning styles based on how individuals approach learning tasks:

- **Activists:** Learners who prefer to engage in new experiences and learn by doing.
- **Reflectors:** Learners who like to observe and think about what they have learned before acting.
- **Theorists:** Learners who prefer to understand the underlying principles and theories behind concepts.
- **Pragmatists:** Learners who want to see how theories can be applied in real-world situations.

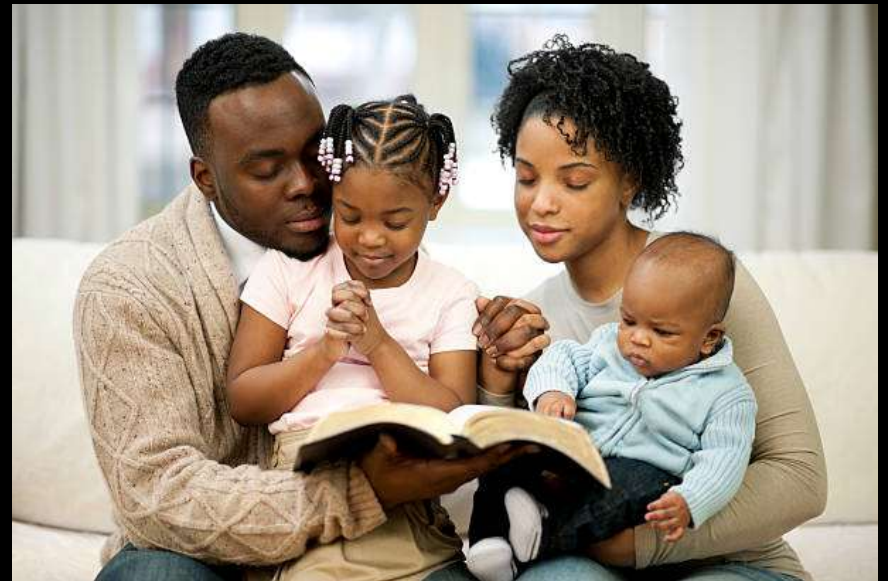

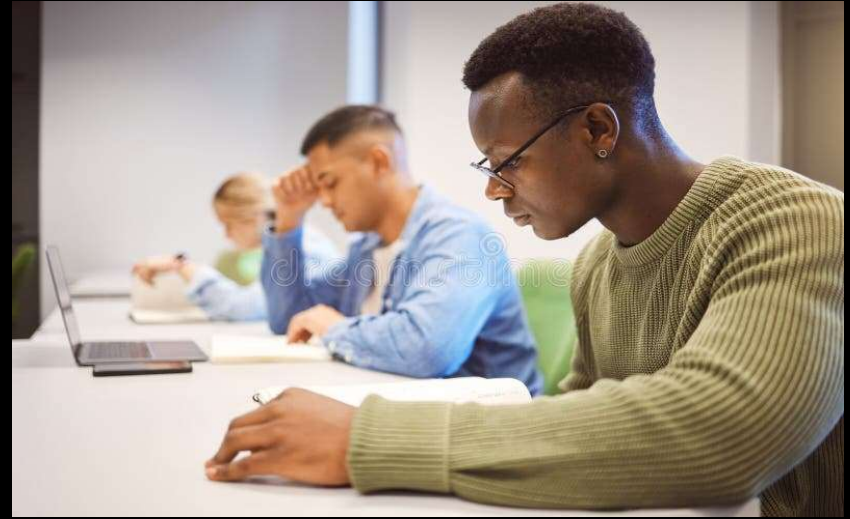
