

How Do We Overcome?

¹¹ And they overcame and conquered him because of The Blood of The Lamb...”

There is a difference in “Overcame/Overcoming,” “Conquered/Conquering”
And “surviving”

Overcome - defeat (an opponent); prevail:

The spiritual victory and triumph over sin, the world, and spiritual adversaries through faith in God. It highlights The Grace and Power of God in the lives of believers.

Old Testament:

Israelites' reliance on God for victory in battles.

For example, David's defeat of Goliath, (1 Samuel 17) overcoming through faith in God.

The Israelites' conquest of Canaan under Joshua and overcoming through obedience to God's commands (Joshua 6).

How Do We Overcome?

“Overcame/Overcoming” (324)

New Testament:

Jesus speaks of overcoming in *John 16:33*:

"I have overcome the world," which assures believers of His victory over worldly challenges and encourages us to find peace in Christ.

The Apostle Paul addresses overcoming in *Romans 12:21*:

urging believers not to be overcome by evil but to overcome evil with good.

Overcoming is deeply intertwined with spiritual warfare, where believers are encouraged to rely on God's strength and guidance.

Ephesians 6:11 – 17 Reminds us The Armor of God available to us, emphasizing the need to stand firm against spiritual attacks.

1 John 5:4-5: "For everyone born of God overcomes the world."

How Do We Overcome?

There is a difference in “Conquered/Conquering” (12)

And “surviving”

We are conquerors!

Conquered is the victory and strength as well as the spiritual triumph that we are promised through faith.

The biblical meaning of "conqueror" transcends physical dominance, but it is the essence of overcoming spiritual battles and challenges.

Associated with victory, overcoming adversaries,
and the ultimate triumph of God's people through faith.

Romans 8:37: “In all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.”

Revelation 2:7 "To the one who overcomes,

I will grant the right to eat from the tree of life in the paradise of God."

Here, the conqueror is one who remains steadfast in faith, ultimately receiving eternal life.

How Do We Overcome?

There is a difference in “Conquered/Conquering” (12)

And “Survive/surviving” (5)

Survive – continue to live or exist, in spite of danger or hardship.

Living beyond the limits of death or existence.

It is associated with God's providence and the resilience of His people.

- ❖ Noah and his family survived the flood (Genesis 8:1-2)
 - ❖ The Israelites survived the wilderness (Exodus 16:1)
 - ❖ 2 Samuel 14:7: "And they are seeking to extinguish my spark that is left, so that there may not survive a name for my husband, nor a remnant upon the earth."
 - ❖ Matthew 24:13, But the one who perseveres to the end will be saved."
- where perseverance is linked to faith and endurance in trials (1 Peter 5:10).


What WORDS are We Using?

- ❖ King James Version (KJV): The word "word" appears 697 times the word "words" appears 546 times and "word's" twice
- ❖ Another source mentions that the word "Word" with a capital "W" (referring to Christ in John 1:1) appears 1,179 times in the KJV
- ❖ New International Version (NIV): The word "word" appears 569 times, and the plural "words" appears 424 times

Be Impeccable With Your Word.





The Truth about Words

- ❖ **Life and Death in the Tongue:** *Proverbs 18:21* “The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.” Our words can have impact on ourselves and others, they can either uplift or harm.
- ❖ **Encouragement and Healing:** *Proverbs 16:24* “Gracious words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the body.” How kind and supportive speech can nurture and bring joy to others.
- ❖ **The Importance of Restraint:** *James 1:26* “If anyone thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue, he deceives his own heart and his religion is worthless...”
This emphasizes the need for self-control in our speech reflects of our faith.
- ❖ **Words Reflect the Heart:** Jesus teaches that “out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks,” *Matthew 12:3*
Our words are a reflection of our inner thoughts and feelings, urging us to cultivate a heart aligned with God’s truth.
