

MATTHEW 28:4-10

4 The guards were so **afraid of him that they shook** and became like dead men.

5 The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. 6 He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and **see the place** where he lay. 7 Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will **see him.**' Now I have told you."

8 So the women hurried away from the tomb, **afraid yet filled with joy**, and ran to tell his disciples. 9 Suddenly Jesus met them. "**Greetings,**" he said. 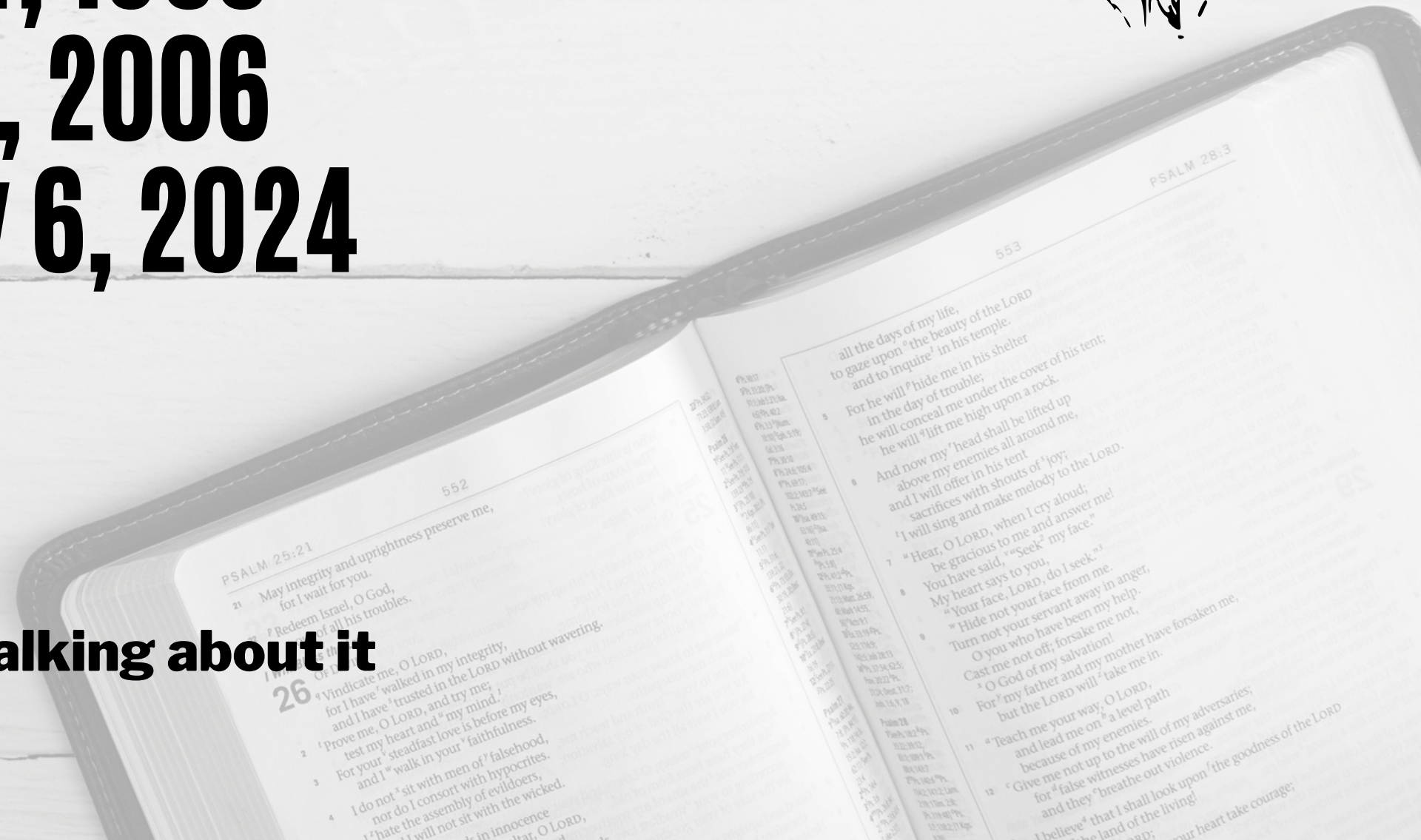

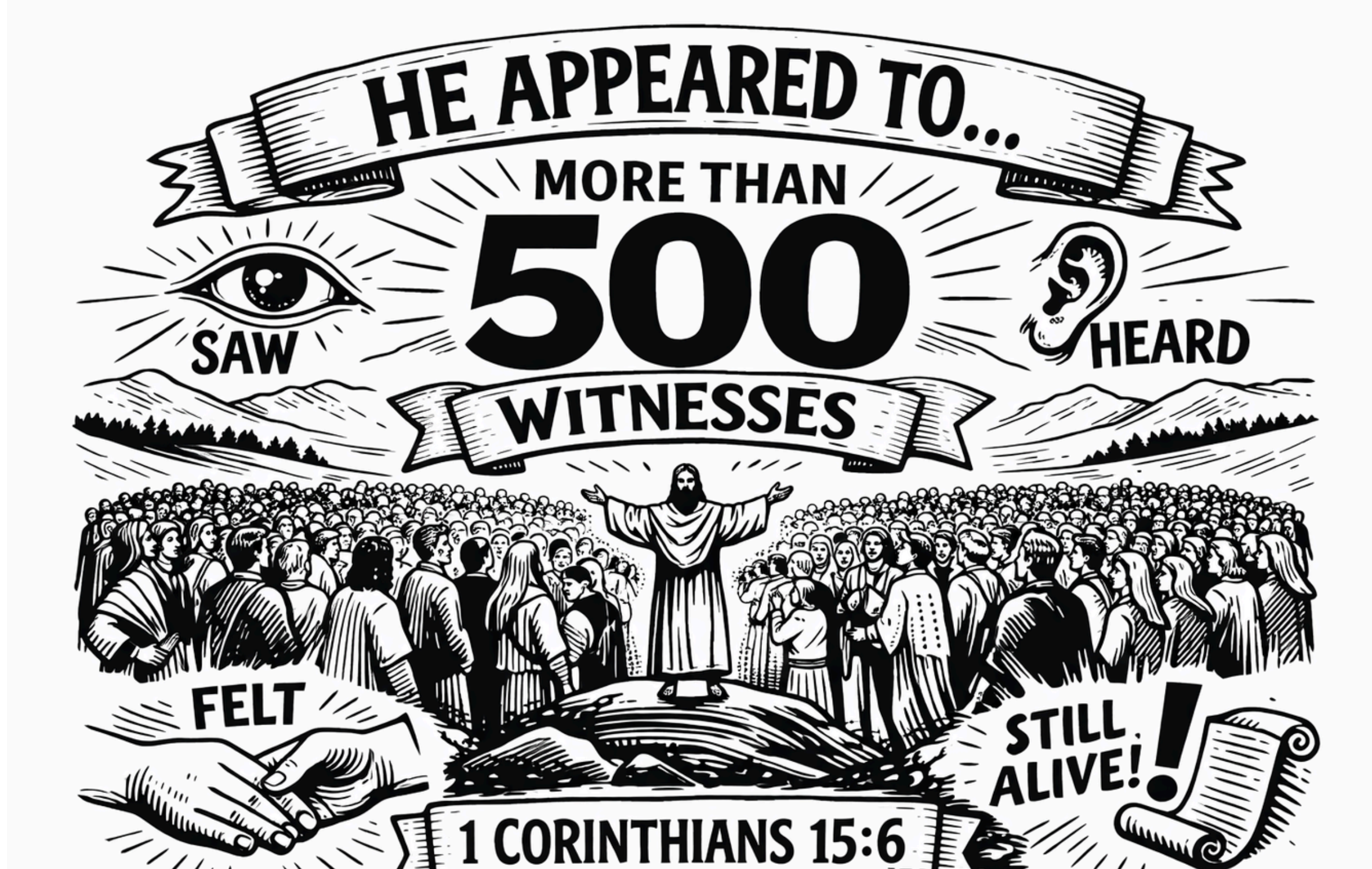

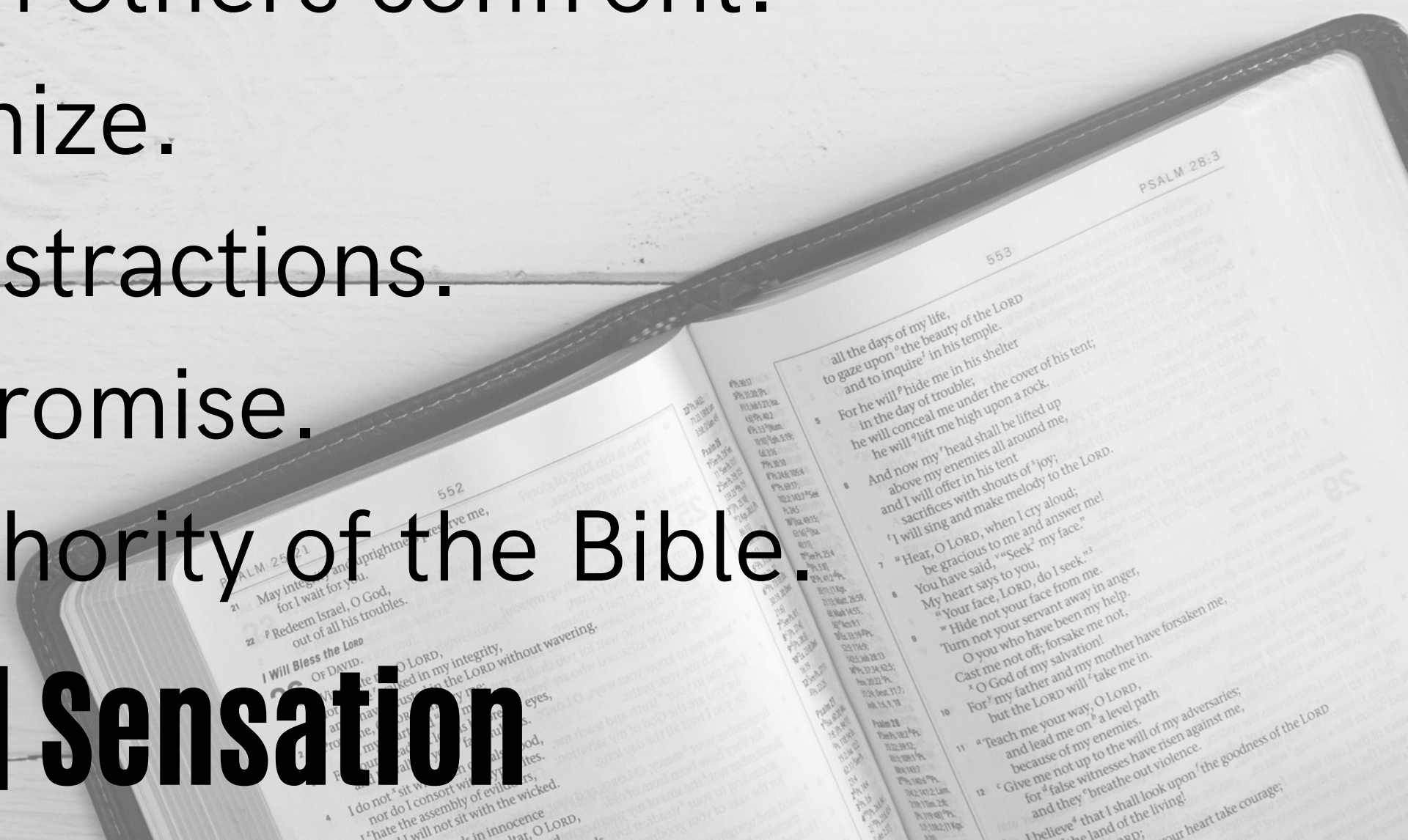




Christian and secular scholars and historians, like Josephus and Thomas Arnold, reported the resurrection and it was so impactful we are still talking.
