James 2:26

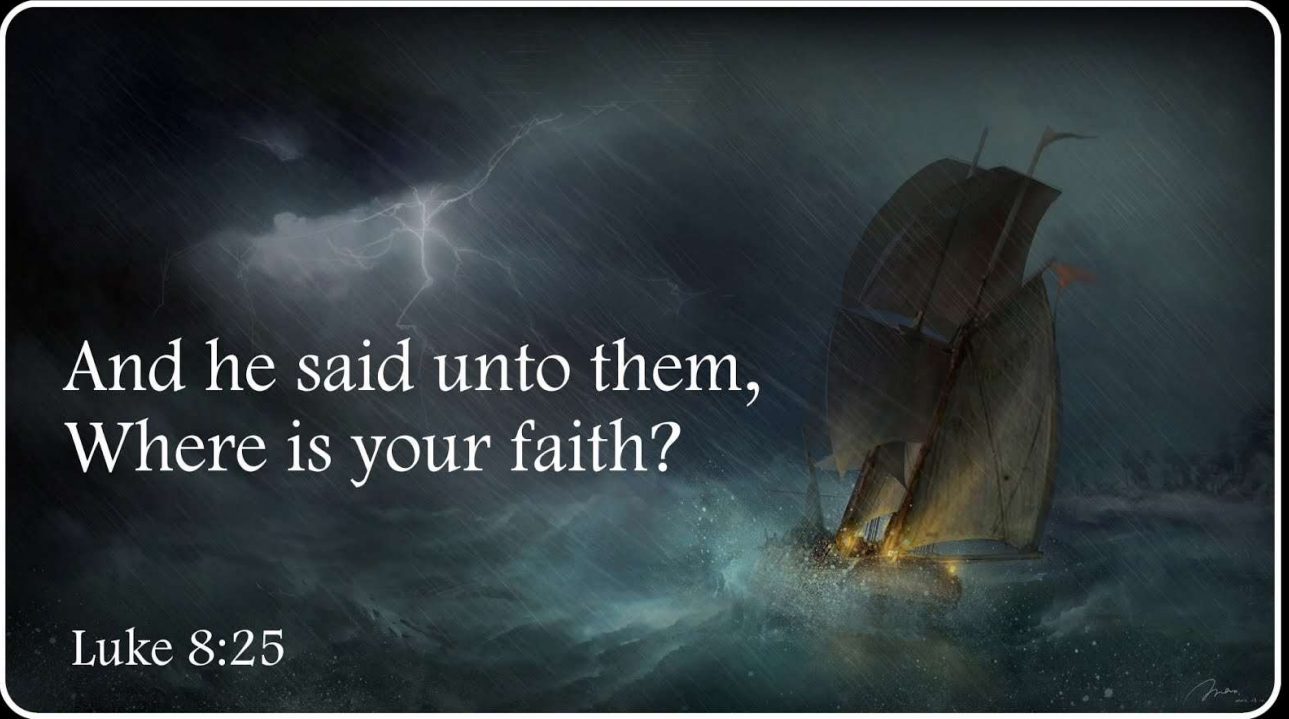

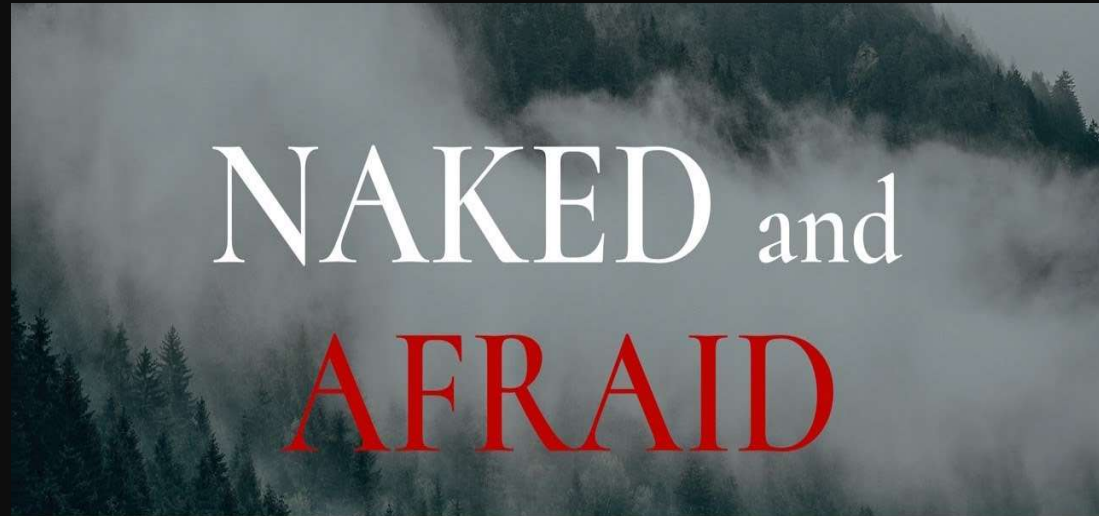

NAKED and AFRAID

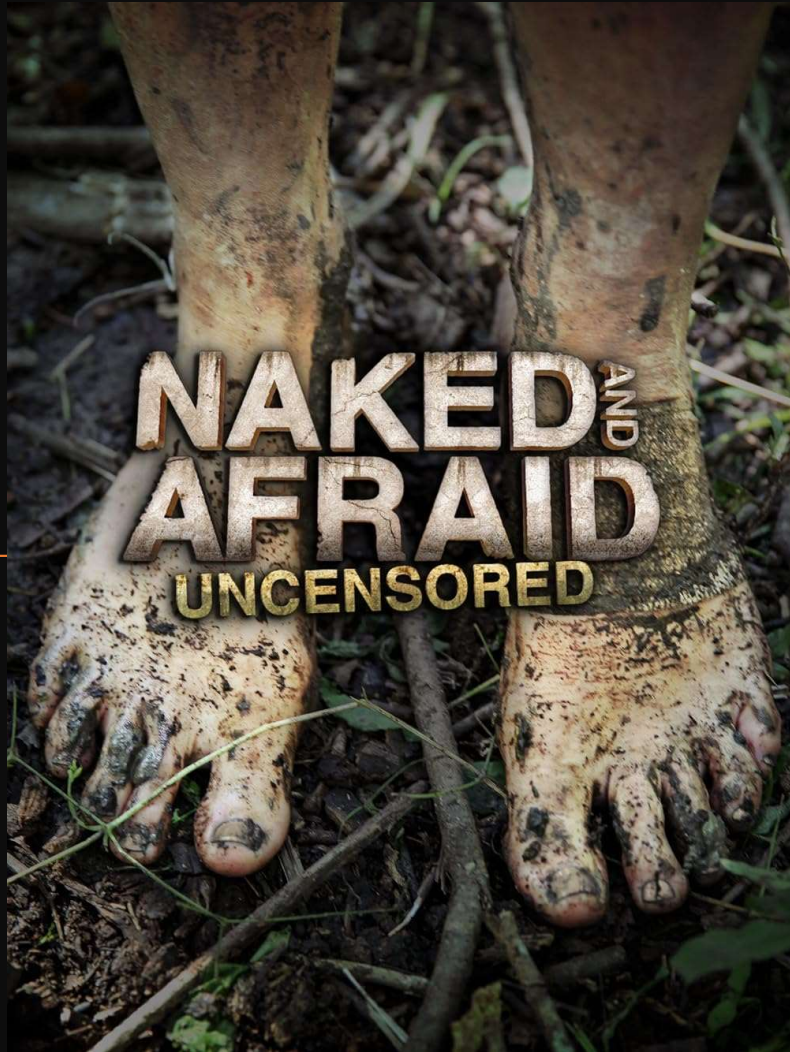
GENESIS 3:1-10

Genesis 3:1 - 13

The story of first human disobedience, showing how temptation led to transgression, the loss of innocence, and the beginning of moral awareness.

Genesis details themes of temptation, free will, accountability, and the origin of human sinfulness.

This passage is the foundation for many theological discussions about human nature, morality, and the need for redemption. And most of all, God's Love in Action.



In each episode, a male and a female survivalist meet for the first time **completely naked** and are challenged to survive in a remote, often extreme environment for 21 days. Each participant is allowed to bring one survival item, such as a machete, fire starter, or hatchet, to aid in their survival. They also receive a satchel with a diary camera and a necklace with a hidden microphone to document their experience when the camera crew is not present. The contestants must **build shelter**, find water, and forage or hunt for food while navigating the harsh conditions of the wilderness. The camera crew is present but cannot intervene except in medical emergencies or extreme situations ...

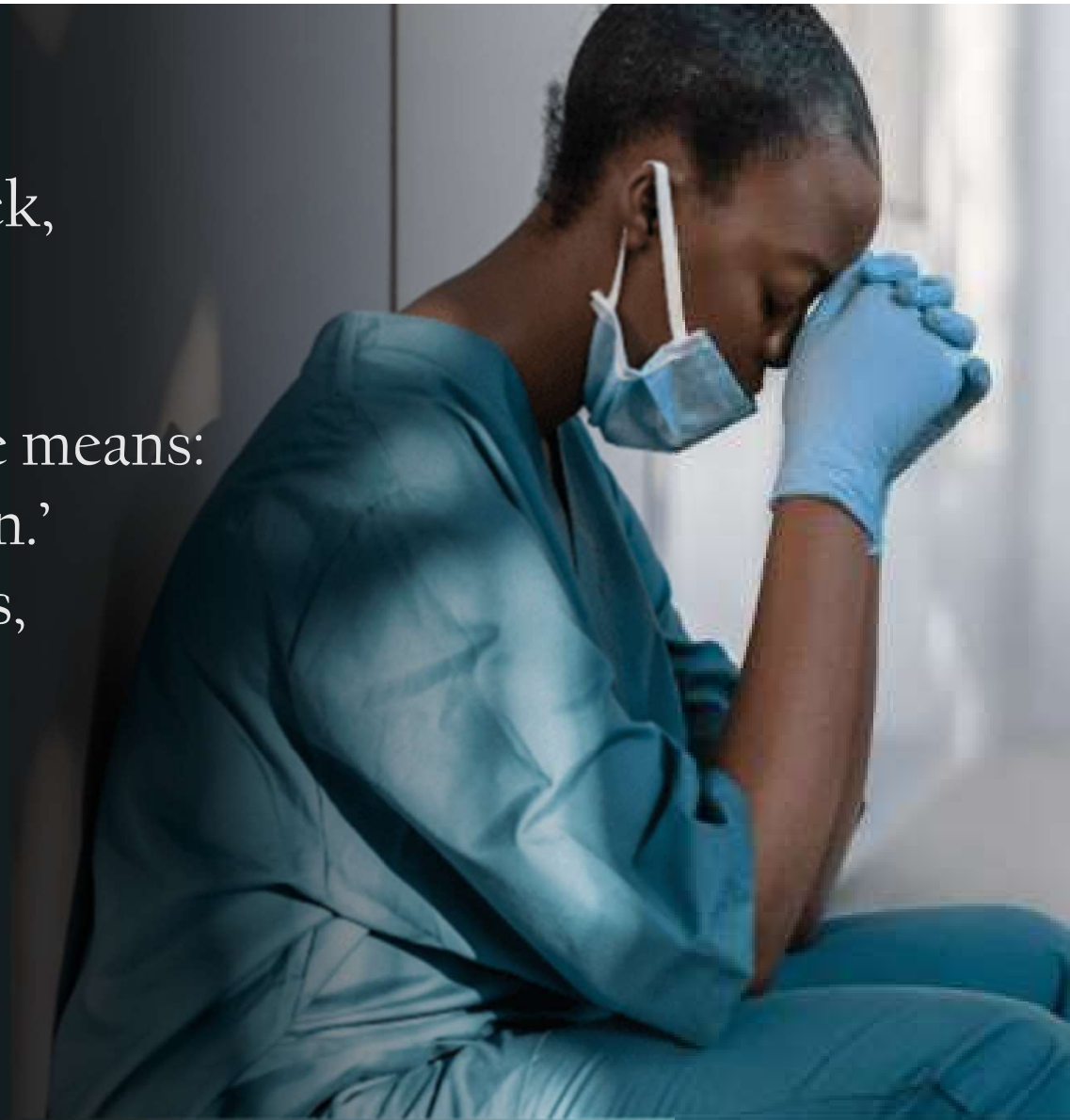

What Does This Internet Acronym Mean?

"FOMO"



FOMO = "Fear Of Missing Out"

- Fear of missing out (FOMO) describes when a person feels increased anxiety or stress from missing out on social events or not having been invited to attend in the first place.
- FOMO feelings are typically amplified for frequent visitors of social networking sites like Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat, where users see a continual stream of pictures, videos and comments of parties, events, outings or other life activities that they may not have been invited to or able to attend.

OTHER MEANINGS

- FOMO = Friends Of Music One
- FOMO = Friends of Mulanje Orphans
- FOMO = Fear Of Missing Oreos
- FOMO = Fort Moultrie (US National Park Service)



Example : Conversation between two friends.

- Friend 1: We didn't tell Sam about our trip. Is it ok?
- Friend 2: I think, it's ok. She seriously has FOMO, she needs to calm down.
- Friend 1: Well, I hope someone else wouldn't tell her.

EXAMPLES

Example sentences

- "I have a cold, but my deep-seated FOMO made me come to this party."
- "His FOMO was too much to deal with, so he drove 2,000 miles to come to this concert."

FOMO

The feeling or perception that other people are experiencing more exciting, enjoyable, or valuable events than you are. Which may trigger anxiety, envy, or dissatisfaction with your own life.

Fear of missing out (FOMO) is the anxiety or apprehension that others are having rewarding experiences from which you are absent, often leading to a desire to stay continually connected.

Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.

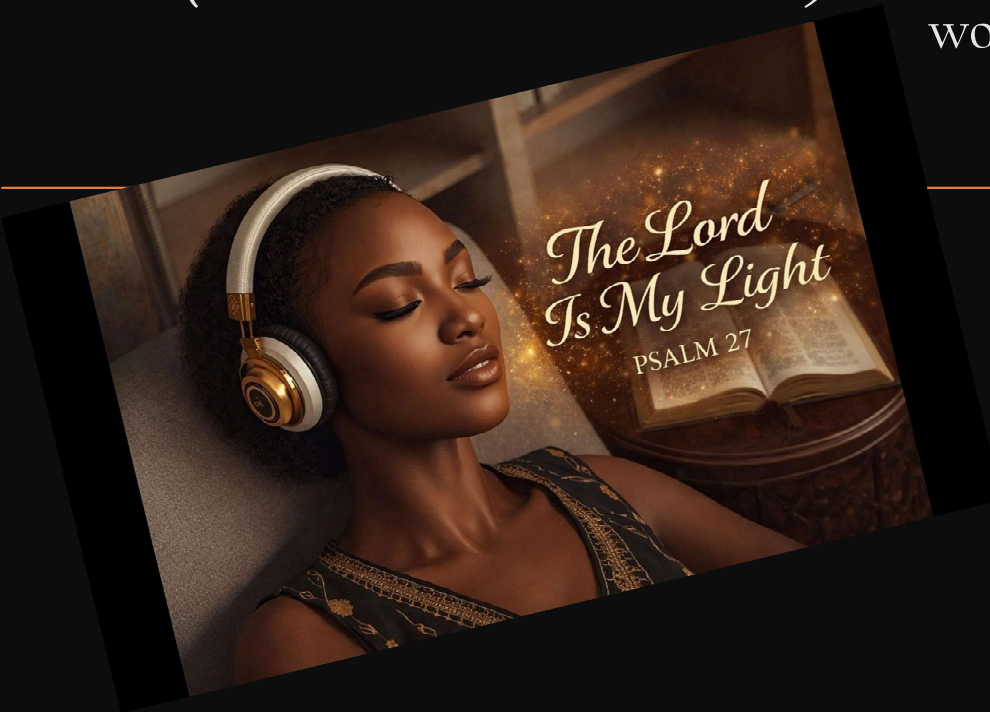
